We do not include WPW participant members on the TEL.</p> <p>United = We will identify members eligible for both WPW and HHP and work collaboratively to follow state recommendations in addressing their unique needs.</p> <p>NOTE = CB-CME's should always ask members if they are enrolled in WPW since they may have enrolled after the TEL was generated.</p>
