Communication Services

- ❑ Mail Service is provided in both Escondido and Oceanside (Libby Lake) offices
- ❑ Telephone use for service-related calls is provided at front desk
- ❑ Copies and faxes can be made throughout the day at both locations by front desk staff as time permits



Shelter Assistance

- ❑ Haven House Shelter
 - ❑ 49 bed Male and Female adult shelter
 - ❑ Low-barrier Shelter
- ❑ ISN-Interfaith Shelter Network
 - ❑ Rotational shelter- moves every couple weeks
- ❑ Behavioral Health Shelters



Case Management Program

- ❑ Available in Escondido, Carlsbad and Oceanside locations
- ❑ Case management services to assist individuals and families become stable-must meet with a case manager regularly



Vita Tax Program

- ❑ The Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) grant program is an IRS initiative designed to support free tax preparation service for the underserved.
