



# COUNTY OF SD DESCRIBES RR AS...

Recovery residences provide a <u>sober and safe environment</u> to facilitate recovery from substance use. While <u>treatment services cannot be provided</u> in a recovery residence, this type of <u>short-term</u> recovery housing allows for <u>stability</u>, and offers <u>peer support</u> to enhance clients' <u>ability to maintain recovery</u> while working towards skill building to <u>achieve longer term housing solutions</u>.

The RRA is funded by the County of San Diego Health and Human Services Agency's Behavioral Health Services.











To collaborate with the community, family members, and treatment providers to support and promote high quality recovery residences for individuals with substance use disorder and co-occurring.

#### RRA QUALITY STANDARDS

- 1. A living environment focused on the whole-person approach to recovery
- 2. Clean, safe and well-maintained residence
- A clear statement of policies is made available to individuals and clearly explained before signing a housing agreement
- Clear process for handling individual grievances and opportunities for individuals to positively influence their environment
- 5. An environment that respects the privacy of the individual
- An environment free of any type of abuse or discrimination that requires all individuals to be treated with dignity, consideration and respect
- Well informed operators and on-site managers

#### **Member Homes**


- Operators are educated and trained on a variety of topics pertinent to running a successful RR

- ✓ Subject to investigation by RRA


- Quality of home varies greatly

- May or may not adhere to local laws and regulations





#### LIMITATIONS OF THE ASSOCIATION:


Not a regulatory or licensing agency
