#### **Thought Leadership**

- HCP is a thought leader and innovative influencer of change, inspiring our community health center members to be on the forefront in providing high quality health care.
- We have effective relationships with local, state and federal health policy officials, and other health care leaders.
- Our education and training programs help members implement best practices and improve operational efficiency.



## Legislative and Advocacy Success

- After several months of intense effort to persuade Congress to avoid a funding cliff for community health centers Congress passed of a bipartisan spending package that included an additional two years of funding for community health centers. Health center funding was increased by \$600 million over the two-year period.
- With continued funding uppermost in members' priorities, we advocated on our member's behalf regarding the State Plan Amendment (SPA), which affects Medicare and Medicaid funding.
- Worked in collaboration with state and regional groups to defend against a repeal of the ACA and to highlight the value of Medicaid.



#### Quality Multi-Lingual Care in Diverse Communities

- 17 member community health centers, including 3 Indian Health centers.
- 135 member practice sites in 3 counties: San Diego, Imperial and Riverside.
- 926,413 patients served for 2,990,994 encounters; 89% of patients were uninsured or underinsured; and 72% were below the Federal Poverty Level (FPL)
- 1 in 5 San Diegans receive their health care at HCP member sites.



#### **Economic Impact**

Our member health centers account for:

- 14 percent of the economic impact of CHCs for the entire state (\$1.17B of \$8.23B)
- 15 percent of total health center jobs for the entire state (9,068 of 59,909)
- 21 percent of total savings to Medi-Cal (\$1.2B of \$5.5B in savings)
