Shared Learning Network



A robust shared learning network of facilitated peer groups for health center executive leadership and various professional staff through which members receive updates on current topics and issues, exchange information, participate in training, share best practices, and make recommendations in the development of health policy.

Training & Technical Assistance



Targeted training and technical assistance to increase competency in areas like compliance, quality improvement, contracting, revenue cycle, financial management, payment transformation systems, health information technology, population health management, emergency preparedness, program evaluation and resource development.
