The mission of the San Ysidro Health Center is, to improve the health and well-being of our community's traditionally underserved and culturally diverse people. SYHC provides a continuum of comprehensive care to over 86,000 patients annually through its vast service delivery network of 26 program sites including: medical clinics, dental clinics, behavioral health centers, HIV/AIDS centers, WIC nutrition centers, mobile units, school-based health centers, pediatric developmental clinic, teen clinic, adult day health center, and opening Sept. 2014: Senior Health Center.
