



- BPHC's Compliance Assessment Processes
- Health Centers' Program Compliance Maintenance

Processes Impacted

- Service Area Competition / Renewal of Designation
- Operational Site Visits



Employment of CEOs and Project Directors



- Health center must directly employ its Chief Executive Officer (CEO) / Project Director
- HRSA will assess compliance beginning in September 2018

FY 2019 Service Area Competition (SAC) and Renewal of Designation (RD)

Objective Application Review Process

NEW: All applications will be independently assessed by a BPHC Reviewer who is not the Project Officer



FY 2019 SAC and RD




Project Period Length Determination

- **NEW**: Demonstration of full compliance required for three-year project period
- Health center cannot have three consecutive one-year project periods

One Year Project Period Awards



NEW: Service Area Competition or Renewal of Designation applicants with one or more conditions at time of award





NEW: All first time SAC awardees

Communication During Application Review

- **NEW**: 14 calendar days for HRSA Reviewer to communicate with applicant
- HRSA Electronic Handbooks (EHBs) External Correspondence Management module required for this communication



IMPORTANT: Ensure Authorizing Official (AO) information is up to date in EHBs to ensure receipt of communications


Monitoring One-Year Project Periods

**Awarded
FY 2019 one-
year project
period**

NEW: OSVs will occur within two to four months of project period start date

NEW: Health centers will be required to submit an overall plan for achieving Program Compliance

Health centers will be required to respond to active or new Progressive Action conditions



Closing Points

Health centers in continuous state of compliance

- Refer to Health Center Program Compliance Manual when completing SAC/Renewal of Designation application
- Prepare for Operational Site Visits using available resources
- Resolve outstanding conditions prior to SAC/RD application
- Seek BPHC staff support to address conditions
