U.S. Health and Human Services recognizes and awards local community health centers for providing effective and high quality health care services Bringing \$2 million of federal funds into their local communities

San Diego, CA – Thirteen Health Center Partners of Southern California <u>member health</u> <u>centers</u> received a combined total of \$1.9 million from the <u>U.S. Health and Human Services</u> (<u>HHS</u>) as recognition for providing effective and high quality health care services.

The grant awards promote continued community health center improvements in the following categories: expanding access to comprehensive care, improving care quality and outcomes, increasing comprehensive care delivery in a cost-effective way, addressing health disparities, advancing the use of health information technology, and delivering patient-centered care.

The Quality Improvement grants were awarded to 1,352 community health centers across all U.S. states, territories and the District of Columbia. Funded by the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), health centers will use these funds to continue to improve quality, efficiency, and the effectiveness of health care delivery in the communities they serve.

"Health Center Partners' members are at the forefront of high quality care, serving more than 800,000 patients across southern California," said Henry Tuttle, President and CEO of Health Center Partners. "We congratulate our members for positively contributing to the physical health of their patients and for being <u>vital economic drivers</u> in the southern California region."
