# Mobile Health During the Pandemic and looking to the Future

Before COVID-19:

Mobile Health Services provides medical services for pediatric population at various sites. Participate in pediatric population related events. Parenting classes at various schools, WIC's and FRC's.

During COVID-19:

Normal operations are halted early March 2020.

Team members offer support to a new department (Health line), COVID -19 Testing, Organizations firsts Mobile Flu clinic, COVID-19 vaccination events and clinic vaccination implementation.

After COVID-19:

Reopen the department as it was pre pandemic, with additional services and cross department collaboration. COVID-19 related services, social media presence, in person visits and offer services beyond the South Bay communities.

Mobile Units provide preventive medical services in the community including:

- School-based (Elementary & High School)
- Affordable Housing Complexes
- Grocery Stores
- Community Parks

# Mobile Unit Services

- **The Mobile Unit will function as an actual clinic, as the team will be able to provide Medical visits and enhance preventive services:**
  - Healthcare for Uninsured Children & Teens  
We also see patients assigned to SYHC through their insurance.
  - School & Sport Physicals
  - TB Tests for minors
  - Hemoglobin
  - Pregnancy Tests, Family Planning & Birth Control
  - Immunizations
  - Blood pressure screening (possible w/ provider visit)
  - Glucose screenings (possible w/ provider visit)
  - COVID-19 and Flu Vaccines
  - Provide Health Promotion & Educational materials, PPE, etc.
